	Bronze	Assessments are set by the subject leader/department level. They are shared with colleagues before the start of the assessment window. Assessments will test students on a range of content/skills learnt in the preceding weeks. They will be completed under full exam conditions in class. Students are allowed reference to their books/revision notes. It is likely that teachers will provide scaffolding and guidance on how to structure their responses. Question need not mirror the structure of GCSE/BTEC exams.
	Silver	Assessments are set by the subject leader/department level. They are shared with colleagues before the start of the assessment window. Assessments will test students on a range of content/skills learnt in the preceding weeks. They will be completed under full exam conditions in class. Students are allowed reference to their revision notes <i>but not their books</i> . It is likely that teachers will provide scaffolding and guidance on how to structure their responses. Where possible questions should mirror the structure of GCSE/BTEC exams.
	Gold	Assessments are set by the subject leader/department level. They are shared with colleagues before the start of the assessment window. Assessments will test students on a range of content/skills learnt in the preceding weeks. They will be completed under full exam conditions in class. Students are <i>not</i> allowed reference to their revision notes or books. It might be appropriate to provide pre-release materials if they are used in the GCSE/BTEC exams. For most students, teachers will <i>not</i> provide scaffolding and guidance on how to structure their responses during the assessment, however this may still be appropriate for some SEN students. Questions should mirror the structure of GCSE/BTEC exams.
	Platinum	Assessments are set by the subject leader/department level. They are shared with colleagues at the start of the assessment weeks (i.e. after the revision period is over). Assessments will test students on a range of content/skills learnt over the year. They will be completed under full exam conditions in class or as mock exams. They will mirror the style of GCSE/BTEC exams.
