Dear Parent/Carer,

Good behaviour and high levels of safety are very important. After some reports of potentially unsafe and poor behaviour from a small number of students on their way to and from school I felt it necessary to contact you to ask for your support.

At Ormiston Ilkeston Enterprise Academy we expect our students to be polite and respectful, towards the environment, each other, and members of the public. Poor behaviour in school uniform damages the reputation of the whole school community and will be sanctioned within school. We want our academy to be a school which is thought highly of in our local community, enabling our students to be proud of their school. We know that you do not agree with poor behaviour in or out of the academy and that you want us to have high standards, so we ask for your continued support.

We expect students to take responsibility for their actions outside of the academy. Next week in assemblies we will remind students about our expectations regarding their behaviours as they travel to and from school. These are clearly set out in our Academy Behaviour and Learning Policy:

All unacceptable behaviour occurring anywhere outside the academy, which have been witnessed by a staff member or reported to the academy, will be addressed using the academy's sanctions and consequences procedures. This will include any unacceptable behaviour when a student:

- *Is taking part in any activity organised by the academy*
- *Is travelling to or from the academy*
- *Is wearing academy uniform*
- *Is in some other way identifiable as a student at the academy*
- *Poses a threat to another student or member of the public*
- *Could adversely affect the reputation of the academy*

I should be grateful if you would remind your child of our expectations and talk to them about the importance of these. Thank you for your continued support.
