Dear Parent/Carer,

Re: Changes to Physical Education Changing Time and Student Expectations

I hope this letter finds you well. We are writing to inform you about a recent adjustment to our Physical Education (PE) program that will directly impact your child's experience during the changing time and expectations we have for students during registration. Effective immediately, students will now have 8 minutes allocated for changing, starting from the end of the previous lesson. It is crucial that during this time, students must be dressed appropriately and ready to actively participate in Physical activities. Failure to do so will result in issuance of a C1. If a student incurs a second C1, a 45-mnute detention will be assigned.

The rationale behind this change is multi-faceted. Firstly, we have observed instances where students are not utilising their changing time effectively, leading to disruptions in the learning process during PE classes.

By imposing a reasonable time limit of 8 minutes, we aim to ensure that students are focused solely on preparing themselves for the upcoming physical activities. This adjustment allows for a more efficient use of lesson time, promoting enhanced learning and progression in our PE curriculum.

In alignment with these changes, we have outlined specific expectations for students during registration:

- 1. **Appropriate Dress Code:** Students must be appropriately dressed and ready for physical activity within the allocated 8-minute changing time/ Failure to comply will result in the issuance of a C1.
- 2. **Class Lines and Silence:** After changing, students are expected to form class lines in the sports hall and maintain silence during the registration process. Any disruptions, talking, or turning around during this time will result in the issuance of a C1.
