# **Disneyland Paris**

#### Who is this for?

Year 9 students (as of September 2023)

#### When will it run?

November 2024 (to February 2025) date to be confirmed

#### What will it involve?

This educational event provides you with everything you need, to undertake a once-in-a-lifetime, truly curriculum-led, trip to Disneyland Paris.

The four-day, three-night trip includes:

- Entry to the resort's two theme parks, Disneyland Park and Walt Disney Studios Park
- One science and STEM seminar
- An interactive workshop and several specialist assignments
- Breakfast and the evening meal
- Transport to Disney (from the agreed departure point)

School trips to Disneyland Paris have now become commonplace in many schools as they offer students a rich tapestry of experiences and an opportunity to develop a wide range of skills. Furthermore, as this trip will be run across all OAT schools, your child, should they be fortunate enough to secure a place, will have the opportunity to work with and form new friendship with students from across the UK. It is therefore vital that any student going on the trip can demonstrate and maintain a positive attitude to learning.



There will be a maximum of 44 places available to all Year 9 students, with a proposed cost of £450, subject to the final booking. If the trip was to be over-subscribed then a selection process will be applied.

As part of the ongoing work of OAT STEMFest we are pleased to announce that in June 2025, Ormiston Academies Trust will be running an enrichment **trip to Miami, USA**.

This trip is open to any current **Year 8 or 9** student, from **any** OAT secondary school. Places will be limited to 30 students from across the 32 secondary schools.

The trip is scheduled to take place at the end of June 2025 and will provide students with a **six-night stay in Miami**. During their time in this vibrant city, students will have the opportunity to immerse themselves in its rich **cultural offerings**. In addition to exploring the cultural wonders of Miami, students will also have various opportunities to expand their knowledge of the natural world, arts, and physical sciences.

This is not just a trip for those who love **science**, but for any student who has a **passion for adventure**, love of learning and **meeting new people**.
