Progress Indicator

The progress indicator is determined by comparing student assessment performance against their expected performance, relative to the rest of the cohort. Students can receive a progress indicator of; Excellent; Above Expected; Expected; Below Expected or Significantly Below Expected.

Attitude to Learning Judgement

Attitude to learning encompasses all the classroom-based behaviours we see from your young person, including their completion of work, engagement in classroom discussion and behaviour within lessons. Students are assigned an attitude to learning judgement from Outstanding, Good, Requires Improvement, Poor.

Homework Completion Information

Homework is a key element in supporting the improvement of outcomes for your young person, this is set weekly and linked to the retrieval of key knowledge that has been previously taught. Students are assigned a homework completion judgement from Outstanding, Satisfactory, Poor and no homework completed.

What Next?

Not all subjects have completed their first assessment and will therefore not display the information outlined above. Subject leaders will inform you once any updates are made.
